



# Pathway to new life in country

MURRAY Bridge's latest housing development has its first public land release this weekend.

On former farm land on the southern side of the River Murray, The Pathways project is a 238-allotment master-planned estate by AVJennings Developments. It is designed to cater for demand in one of the state's fastest growing regions.

AVJennings will launch the Casuarina Release tomorrow.

A selection of 40 premium allotments are priced from \$60,000 and range

from 412sq m to 2882sq m. Housing styles include courtyard and villa and country living homes.

AVJennings Developments land general manager Gary Page said Pathways captured "the sense of space and freedom associated with country living".

Customers who contract to purchase land between tomorrow and February 24 will enjoy a stamp duty rebate if they settle within 90 days of signing the contract to purchase land at Pathways.
